
Bristol Bay Region



- ❑ Region is 47,000 square miles in size
- ❑ 30 communities
- ❑ Over 2,200 miles of coastline and 11,500 miles of rivers and streams

Methods

- ▣ **Selection of Three Communities** (Oct 2011)
- ▣ **Community Climate Change Health Assessments** (Oct 2013)
 - *Scoping* – describe local conditions & engage stakeholders
 - *Surveying* – collect descriptive information & quantitative data
 - *Analysis* – examine data for relationships between climate impact and health outcomes
 - *Planning* – share draft findings with community and initiation of response planning
- ▣ **Public Outreach Component** (ongoing)
