The Immediate Action Workgroup (IAWG) of the Governor's Executive Sub-Cabinet on Climate Change will hold a public meeting from 9:00 am until 12 Noon on Monday, February 23, 2009.

The purpose of the Workgroup is to focus on short term (12 - 18 month) projects and goals for Alaska communities that have been identified as needing immediate assistance because of increased flooding, erosion, forest fires, and other potential disasters due to impacts caused in part by climate change.

The primary focus of the February 23, 2009 meeting will be to review the draft IAWG 2009 Recommendation Report.
