Public meetings of the Immediate Action Workgroup will occur on the dates and locations noted below. The Governor's Sub-Cabinet on Climate Change formed the Immediate Action Workgroup to address known threats to communities caused by coastal erosion, thawing permafrost, flooding and wildfires.

The Workgroup will make recommendations on how to execute a coordinated state, federal and local effort to assist the communities of Newtok, Shishmaref, Kivalina, Koyukuk, Unalakleet and Shaktoolik who face imminent threats of loss of life, loss of infrastructure, loss of public and private property, or health epidemics due in-part to a changing climate.
