OF THE GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE SUB-CABINET ON CLIMATE CHANGE**

Public meetings of the Immediate Action Workgroup (IAWG) of the Governor's Executive Sub-Cabinet on Climate Change will occur on the dates and locations noted below.

The purpose of the Workgroup is to focus on short term (12 - 18 month) projects and goals for Alaska communities that have been identified as needing immediate assistance because of increased flooding, erosion, forest fires, and other potential disasters due to impacts caused in part by climate change.

The Workgroup will make recommendations on how to execute a coordinated state, federal and local effort to assist those communities that face imminent threats of loss of life, loss of infrastructure, loss of public and private property, or health epidemics due in-part to a changing climate.
