OF THE GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE SUB-CABINET ON CLIMATE CHANGE**

The Immediate Action Workgroup (IAWG) of the Governor's Executive Sub-Cabinet on Climate Change will hold a public meeting from 10:00 am until 3:30 pm on Tuesday, October 28, 2008. The IAWG meeting will be immediately followed by a technical presentation from 3:30 – 5 pm.

The purpose of the Workgroup is to focus on short term (12 - 18 month) projects and goals for Alaska communities that have been identified as needing immediate assistance because of increased flooding, erosion, forest fires, and other potential disasters due to impacts caused in part by climate change. The primary outcome of the October 28, 2008 meeting will be a draft workplan for the next 6-8 months.
