

## **Energy Supply and Demand TWG – Update**

Our last meeting was Friday, September 19<sup>th</sup>. Prior to this meeting, I've participated in one other TWG meeting since coming aboard as the local Alaska facilitator.

The group is not ready to finalize the catalog, or ready to do any balloting at this point. The ESD TWG members have expressed their desire to have more in depth discussion on the catalog options. We have a meeting scheduled for Tuesday, September 30<sup>th</sup> from 830 a – Noon to discuss the catalog options. The meeting will be held at the Alaska Energy Authority and AIDEA boardroom. The group would also like to get a better understanding of the overall process, and possibly have a discussion with the Commissioner (similar to the September 11<sup>th</sup> meeting with Commissioner Harting).

Various members of the TWG have “homework” that will help the TWG with their analysis of the options, which they will bring forward on the 30<sup>th</sup>, if not before.

I have made calls to a number of TWG members who have not participated in past phone meetings. Some did join us on the 19<sup>th</sup>, and others were unavailable for various reasons.

We do have a face to face meeting scheduled for October 16<sup>th</sup> here in Anchorage. Chris James and Jeremy Fisher from CCS (Synapse Energy) will be here as well. We are hopeful of working in depth the catalog options, with the hope that we can begin the balloting process shortly afterwards. TWG members want to look at how the options would be quantified regarding costs and benefits, and how the options might be implemented.
